



By order and direction of the Provincial Health Officer (PHO), all events and social gatherings are suspended to significantly reduce COVID-19 transmission related to social interactions and travel. The order is in effect from November 19, 2020 to January 8, 2021 at midnight. There are to be no social gatherings of any size at your residence with anyone other than your household or core bubble.

For example:

- Do not invite friends or extended family to your household
- Do not host gatherings outdoors
- Do not gather in your backyard
- Do not have playdates for children
- Stick to your core bubble

For most people, their core bubble is their immediate household. An immediate household is a group of people who live in the same dwelling.
